

The Williams Family Scholarship To Woodberry Forest Sports Camp

Scholarship Information and Selection Criteria:



Background Information – Woodberry Forest Sports Camp is a three-week overnight sports camp held each summer at Woodberry Forest School in Orange, VA. This year's camp will be held **June 18-July 7, 2017** and will feature a variety of sports including basketball, soccer, golf, lacrosse, and swimming. Camp facilities on Woodberry Campus include two new state-of-the-art artificial turf playing fields, two gymnasiums, outdoor swimming pool, wrestling room, excellent all-weather tennis courts, grasstex track, the Rapidan River, and a nine-hole golf course. The Harry Barbee Jr. Sports Center facilities include an indoor pool, 200 meter track, 5 basketball courts, 5 tennis courts, 3 squash courts and volleyball and racquetball courts. One participant from The First Tee of Greater Charlotte will be selected to receive a scholarship to attend the camp.

Eligibility - For a participant to qualify for the Williams Family Scholarship to attend The Woodberry Forest Sports Camp, they must meet all of the following minimum requirements:

- 12 or 13 years old as of the camp date (6/15/17)
- Active in The First Tee database upon submittal of application
- Entering the 7th or 8th grade for the 2017-2018 School Year
