Selection Criteria

- Applicants must be a <u>rising 6th grader</u>, 7th grader, or <u>rising 8th grader</u> for the 2019-2020 school year
- The application must be completed with inclusion of the short essay
- Completed applications must be submitted to Brittnay Cross by Friday, March 8th, 2019

The committee will review the essays and applications and inform the recipient(s) by March 15th, 2019.

Upon their selection, scholarship recipient(s) will have the opportunity to choose which camp(s) they would like to attend.

NOTE: Transportation to and from Charlotte Country Day School will be the responsibility of the recipient(s) parent/guardian.
