

Application Deadline: April 27, 2020

Overview:

The PURE Insurance Championship Impacting The First Tee is a premier event intended to showcase the best participants in the First Tee network. This tournament is an official PGA TOUR Champions event, at Pebble Beach Golf Links on the Monterey Peninsula, that pairs one junior with a PGA TOUR Champions player and two amateurs. To be selected, juniors are measured in both golf proficiency and life skills knowledge. The tournament is televised nationally on Golf Channel.

Participant Selection:

Up to **78** participants are eligible to play in the event. The 78 participants from The First Tee will be selected based on the online applications. If selected, participants must be available to travel to California on September 15 – 21, 2020.

Eligibility Requirements:

For participants of First Tee to be eligible for the PURE Insurance Championship Impacting The First Tee, <u>they must meet</u> <u>ALL of the following requirements:</u>

- Participants must be in the 14 18 age range. Applicants must reach their 14th birthday on or before September 17, 2020. Applicants must not reach their 19th birthday before September 21, 2020.
- Classified as a high school freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior as of fall semester 2020. High school seniors at the time of application deadline are not eligible to apply, as they will be full-time college students or 19 years old at the date of the event.
- Acceptable Golf Ability must have a USGA handicap of 6 or better for males and 8 or better for females
- Players must be physically and mentally able to play up to 5 rounds in one week, while walking, carrying their own bag, and keeping pace of play according to the PGA TOUR Rules and Competitions guidelines
- Entered in Salesforce and has been an active participant for a minimum of three years
- Must be at Birdie level or higher, at the time of application deadline
- Chapters must have signed their contract at least 3 years before application deadline in order to submit applicants
- Each chapter may nominate up to **five** participants for the PURE Insurance Championship Impacting The First Tee. We encourage the participants to reflect the diversity (age, ethnicity, gender, etc.) of the chapter.
- Participants who previously attended the event are not eligible

Application Process:

Applications will be submitted online at thefirsttee.fluidreview.com; <u>please follow the instructions in the "Quick Start Guide"</u> on how to complete this process. The Quick Start Guide is available on the Chapter Intranet, please contact your <u>chapter representative to obtain a copy</u>. The online application will consist of the following:

Below is a copy of the application you will need to complete online; please refer to the application below to make sure that you have all of the information you need to complete your application online. <u>Online application MUST be</u> <u>submitted by the First Tee participant. First Tee will NOT accept paper applications, emails, or correspondence from</u> <u>families of participants. The deadline to apply online is April 27, 2020.</u>

Selection Process:

Following the closing date of April 27, 2020, a judging committee made up of First Tee headquarters staff members, chapter staff members and tournament officials will review the above items and assign point values to the categories. Please note that after the committee reviews the applications, a phone and/or webcam interview with a participant, chapter coach or executive director <u>may</u> be necessary to make the final selections. <u>EVERY</u> element of the application will be read thoroughly and evaluated by the judging committee so the selection of participants is as fair and un-biased as possible. All of the documents and information provided will be stringently reviewed. Once they identify the candidates that will be invited to the PURE Insurance Championship Impacting The First Tee, **the participants will be announced on Golf Channel Morning Drive in July.**

Transportation and Lodging:

First Tee has secured a discounted room rate at the Hyatt Regency Monterey for players and chaperones to utilize. All guest room arrangements will need to be made by contacting the hotel directly. A reservation link will be sent to all participants for them to make their own arrangements.

First Tee will provide each participant who will be flying a flat stipend of \$2100 to assist with the cost of airfare and lodging for the participant and chaperone. Participants who live within 150 miles of Pebble Beach will be required to drive, and receive a flat stipend of \$1750 to assist with the cost of travel and lodging.

First Tee, in partnership with Hertz, has secured a complimentary rental car for each chaperone. The rental car is only valid for Sept. 14-21 and any additional days or rentals will need to be made at your own expense.

- Denim shorts, short-shorts, cut-off shorts, gym shorts, jeans, short skirts
- Tattoos (must be covered)
- Body piercing (other than earrings for females)

Proper attire is required at all times including meetings and free time. Questionable attire will be reviewed by on-site staff. Should a host facility have a stricter dress code, its policy will take precedence.
